BREDASDORP BASIN RECOVERABLE RESERVES REVIEW

IN 1994 HB&A undertook with Tuppeny Associates Inc. a complete review of the Bredasdorp Basin gas and condensate reserves as contracted for by CEF (the Central Energy Fund) via KMPG Forensic Audit team to confirm the final recoverable reserves likely to be achieved from the development of the FA and Satellites and EM gas fields for gas supply to the worlds first commercial scale GTL plant at Mossel Bay (under construction). This was done in association with experts from Texas, London, and France, and the final results reported to the South African Auditor General, IDC, CEF and Ministry of Mines and Energy.
